09/0718	ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION BROADBAND – Councillor Hutchinson is trying to get some funding from Rory Stewart MP's campaign for better broadband. LIGHTS – Unfortunately EDC after September will no longer maintain the street lighting in the parish. The clerk will write to EDC asking for prices for new bulbs and cost of running street lights as this information has not been sent out. A66 – Councillor Hutchinson sent an e-mail to Jonathan Reid asking when the review report of the A66 would be available. There is a meeting on the 16 th August regarding the A66 and Councillor Hutchinson will attend.

Councillor Watson asked if he could have a replacement plastic reflector outside his property as the grass cutter ran it over.</p> <p>LITTLE MUSGRAVE - Councillor Clarke reported that the grass verges were cut back, but some of the village was missed and would the clerk please ask them to come back and finish. There are still over hanging trees which Councillor Clarke is still waiting for Bob Dow to get back to him regarding them.</p> <p>FLITHOLME – Nothing to discuss</p> <p>COLLINSON TRUST – Councillor Hutchinson gave an update. An advert has gone in the way asking for applicants to apply for the funding. The Rev Sarah Lunn has now left the area and there won't be a replacement for some time. Councillor Hutchinson will ask the other members if a lay person or preacher would be acceptable on the trust.</p>	HS

He also attended a meeting in Kirkby Stephen regarding the Appleby Horse Fair which was very well attended. Kirkby Stephen had a major problem with the amount of travellers this year and alongside the road side from Brough to Kirkby Stephen was full of travellers which made traveling to Kirkby Stephen very dangerous. Residents felt the police did not do enough and they were not enough to cover the fair.
